**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF EMERSON BOULEVARD BETWEEN THE JUNCTIONS OF McCaffrey Avenue AND FREEMAN AVENUE, FOR A FOURTH OF JULY CELEBRATION TO BE HELD BY LOCAL BUSINESS THE DIVIDE.**

**WHEREAS**, the DiVide is a viable business in the Town of Encampment, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Encampment wishes to work with its businesses to boost their revenue, thereby benefiting the sales tax revenues; and

**WHEREAS**, the DiVide has submitted a request to hold a Fourth of July celebration outdoors, having limited space to do so, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Encampment does have a provision for street closure in conjunction with a liquor license or other community event; and


**WHEREAS**, traffic control, crowd safety and barricades have been addressed to the satisfaction of the town of Encampment; and
