2.24.010 Term.

The mayor, by and with the consent of the council, shall appoint a competent and suitable person to the office of town attorney. Such appointee shall be licensed and admitted to practice law in the state of Wyoming. He shall hold office from the time of his appointment until his successor is appointed and qualified. (Prior code § 1-506)

2.24.020 Duties.

The town attorney shall be the legal advisor of the council and town officials; he shall commence, prosecute and defend all suits and actions necessary to be commenced, prosecuted or defended on behalf of the corporation, or that may be ordered by the council, and shall attend meetings of the council, and give his opinion upon any matter submitted to him, either orally or in writing, as may be required. (Prior code § 1-507)
