2.28.010 Appointment.

The mayor, by and with the consent of the council, may appoint a suitable and qualified person to the office of town engineer. Such engineer shall be a duly registered professional engineer or land surveyor if it is possible to appoint a person with the above qualifications. He shall hold office from the time of his employment until his successor is appointed and qualified. (Prior code § 1-511)

2.28.020 Duties.

The town engineer shall have general supervision of all work done on the streets, alleys, parks, water wells, water mains, and sewer mains, and shall have supervision of the tow dump ground and of the disposal of garbage, ashes, refuse in the town, with all the powers of chief of police of and in said town. He shall make records of the minutes of his surveys and of all work done for the town, including sewers, extension of water system and accurately make such plats, sections, profiles and maps as may be necessary in the prosecution of any public work, which shall be turned over to his successor.
