### 10.08.010 Applicability.

The provisions of this chapter relating to the operation of vehicles refer exclusively to the operation of vehicles upon public streets or highways except as otherwise provided. (Prior code § 10.201)

## 10.08.020 Applicability of chapter to vehicles of state, municipalities, etc.

A. The provisions of this chapter applicable to the drivers of vehicles upon the streets shall apply to the drivers of all vehicles owned and operated by the United States, this state or any county, city, town or other political subdivision of the state, except as provided in this section and subsection and subject to such specific exceptions as are set forth in this chapter with reference to authorized emergency vehicles.

B. Unless specifically made applicable, the provisions of this chapter shall not apply to persons, teams, motor vehicles and other equipment while actually engaged in work upon a street but shall apply to such persons and vehicles when traveling to or from such work. (Prior code § 10-102)

## 10.08.030 Applicability of chapter to persons riding animals, etc.

Every person riding an animal or driving any animal drawn vehicle upon a roadway shall be granted all the rights and shall be subject to all of the duties applicable to the driver of a vehicle by this chapter, except those provisions of this chapter which by their very nature can have no application. (Prior code § 10-103)

### 10.08.040 Obedience to police.

No person shall willfully fail or refuse to comply with a lawful order or direction of any police officer invested by law with authority to direct, control or regulate traffic. (Prior code § 10-104)

# 10.08.050 Rights of owners of real property not abridged by chapter.

Nothing in this chapter shall b construed to prevent the owner of real property, used by the public for purposes of vehicular travel by permission of the owner and not as matter of right, from prohibiting such use or from requiring other or different or additional conditions than those specified in this chapter or otherwise regulating such use as may seem best to such owner. (Prior code § 10.106)

### 10.08.060 Violation-Penalty.

It is unlawful, and, unless otherwise declared in this title with respect to particular offenses, a misdemeanor for any person to do any act forbidden or fail to perform any act required in this title, unless otherwise provided any violation of this title shall be subject to the penalty provisions of Section 1.12.010 of this code. (Prior code § 10-105)
