BUILDING NUMBERING SYSTEM

15.32.010 Building numbering.

A. It is unlawful for any person to erect or maintain any house or building numbered not in conformity with the provisions of this chapter.

B. All streets running easterly and westerly shall be designated and known in those parts thereof east of McCaffery Avenue as “East” and the numbers on the houses thereon shall increase from west to east, and in those parts thereof west of McCaffery Avenue as “West” and the numbers on the houses thereon shall increase from east to west. All streets running northerly and southerly shall be designated and the numbers on the houses thereon shall increase from north to south beginning with First Street.

1. Mobile home parks shall be numbered by lot address plus each mobile home within shall be assigned a numerical space number.

2. The first lot in each block shall be issued numbers 01 or 02 depending on the side of the street it is on.

3. In the district each business fronting the street on the ground level shall carry a whole number designation with half numbers being used for businesses in the rear or upstairs.

C. All numbers of houses or buildings on the east or south side of the street shall be odd numbers and all numbers of houses or buildings on the west or north side of the street shall be even numbers.

D. Each number shall represent a platted lot, per street, as shown on the official map of the town, shall be designated and known according to the schedule on file in the office of the town clerk.

E. If more than one building is located where one number is designated by this section, the first in order shall take the number designated, and the other shall take a half number; and if apartments shall be constructed on the same lot, they shall be designated by a letter after the number, the lowest floor taking the first letter.

F. The street a house or building faces shall determine its address.

G. It shall be the duty of the town clerk, upon request of any house or building owner, to inform such owner or occupant of the number designated for his or her house or building by the provisions of this section. If any owner or occupant shall fail to properly mark or number his house or building as herein required, it shall be the duty of the town clerk to cause such house or building to be marked with its designated number, and the cost of marking the same shall be collected by the town clerk from the owners. The town clerk shall be empowered to rule on and assign a number I a nonconforming situation. (Prior code § 6-103)
